Our commitment

Our club is committed to providing a safe, fair and happy environment for the participation of all our members. We have implemented some club rules so as to help with efficient and effective club management.

Our rules

1. All members, parents and carers must abide by our club policies and procedures
 2. All players and team officials must wear our official team uniforms on the diamond. All playing shirts are to be tucked in so as to look "smart" and "tidy" and worn with pride
 3. All members must not misuse or damage any club equipment that is provided. Any damages must be reported so that a replacement can be put in place
 4. All members must be financial prior to the first round of games, unless a payment plan has been discussed, agreed upon and implemented with an executive board member
 5. All senior players and parents or carers of junior players are expected to cover club duties, such as canteen, umpiring and ground duties each week. Managers will provide a roster for teams. Teams or individuals who fail to cover duties will be fined. First and second grade teams will be required to umpire each other
 6. Any member who wishes to gain a level one accreditation to coach, score or umpire will be liable for 50% of course fees. The member will then be required to play an "active" role as a team official in the current season. If the member returns to our club in the following season, then he/she will be reimbursed the cost incurred in the prior season
 7. All team officials must be accredited level 1 or higher with the exception of trainees. We will help you gain your accreditation and provide training and guidance where necessary. This includes our Junior Blues Programme
 8. All committee members will be provided training and assistance to help with their roles
 9. All junior representative players and team officials will be gifted a monetary donation each season. The amount will be reviewed annually by our club committee
 10. Members are encouraged to become a Social Member (\$10 for Adults \$2.50 for children) of our Major Sponsor, Club Maitland City in Rutherford. ABSOLUTELY NO advertising material or propaganda will be sent to your child. They will receive a water bottle in return for membership
